...was Compliance Officer and authorized signatory of Siemens AG Österreich, Vienna, between March 2009 and June 2018. In this function she was specifically in charge of the entire preparation and self-reliant execution of Internal Investigations in Austria and various countries in Central Eastern Europe (CEE), cooperating with in-house lawyers of Siemens AG, Munich, and labour law specialists. Her responsibility as Compliance Officer also meant that she had to advise and instruct certain managers and employees to obey and follow the contemporary Compliance Management System at any time.
